- P 01 – APPOINTMENT of COUNCIL PRESIDENT. (WILLIAM MARSH)
- P 02 – APPOINTMENT of COUNCIL VICE PRESIDENT. (STEVEN MOORE)
- P 03 – APPOINTMENT of LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL. (BILLIE J. MOORE, ESQ.)
- P 04 – APPOINTMENT of CLASS III PLANNING BOARD MEMBER. (FRANK GILLIAM, JR.)
- P 05 – APPOINTMENT to the PURCHASING BOARD. (RIZWAN MALIK)

- P 12 – AUTHORIZATION for PENALTY of FOUR (4%) PERCENT to be CHARGED to ANY TAX PAYER with DELINQUENT TAXES in EXCESS of TEN THOUSAND (\$10,000.00.) DOLLARS PURSUANT to N.J.S.A. 54:4-67.
- P 13 – AUTHORIZATION for and INTEREST RATE of EIGHT (8%) PERCENT on the FIRST ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (\$1,500.00) DOLLARS of any DELINQUENT TAXES and at the RATE of EIGHTEEN (18%) PERCENT on ANY AMOUNT in EXCESS of SAME, PURSUANT to N.J.S.A. 54:5-67.
