Memorandum of Understanding

Amendment

The purpose of this Amendment is to establish an agreement by which the FBI will use Joint Law Enforcement Operations (JLEO) funding provided by the Department of Justice's Assets Forfeiture Fund (AFF) to reimburse ATLANTIC CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT for one-time Fiscal Year 2017 equipment purchases. It also lays out the tracking requirements that accompany the reimbursement of these equipment purchases. The tracking requirements (Revision 2) applies to equipment having an individual cost greater than \$500.

The aforementioned equipment is to be purchased for state and local task force officers (TFOs) serving on FBI-led task forces. In accordance with AFF statute, JLEO equipment reimbursements are only available for costs of state or local law enforcement officers that are incurred in a joint law enforcement operation with a Federal law enforcement agency participating in the AFF.

This Amendment modifies the standing AFF Memorandum of Understanding between the Federal Bureau of Investigation and ATLANTIC CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT hereinafter referred to as the "parties", to define the scope of work and responsibilities of the parties concerning the reimbursement of funds utilizing JLEO funding for equipment purchased by ATLANTIC CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT. This Amendment consists of 2 Revisions. For ease of review, affected paragraphs or subsections are reprinted with new language shown in bold and original language to be deleted shown as strikeouts. Topic headings are shown as they appear in the original document, typically in bold face type.

Revision 1: The following language is to be added to the agreement in Property/Equipment:

Equipment Purchase and Reimbursement

The FBI will reimburse ATLANTIC CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT for the purchase—which must be invoiced to the FBI before September 15, 2017—of the following pieces of property/equipment, not to exceed a total cost of \$270,000.00.

Revision 2; The following language is to be added to the agreement in Property/Equipment:

Equipment Tracking

Equipment purchased by the ATLANTIC CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT for the Task Force and reimbursed by the FBI shall be tracked consistent with the ATLANTIC CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT asset management processes. In order to comply with Department of Justice tracking requirements, these asset management processes will be supplemented with the following requirements for equipment purchased under this MOA to the extent that these requirements are not already incorporated into current asset management processes.

a. ATLANTIC CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT asset management processes and procedures will ensure the identification and tracking of equipment make, model, serial number (if applicable), description/classification, location, responsible user, and how the equipment is utilized by the Task Force.


b. ATLANTIC CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT will perform an annual inventory of all equipment purchased under this MOA to ensure asset management data is current, accurate and complete and to ensure the equipment is only used for Task Force purposes.

c. Task Force will produce equipment and asset management/inventory records for audit/inspection at the request of the Department of Justice/FBI.


APPROVALS

**RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AN AMENDED AGREEMENT WITH THE
FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION (FBI) NEWARK SSTF
AND THE ATLANTIC CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the FBI will use Joint Law Enforcement Operations (JLEO) funding provided by the Department of Justice's Assets Forfeiture Fund (AFF) to reimburse the Atlantic City Police Department for one-time Fiscal Year 2017 equipment purchases; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned equipment is to be purchased for state and local task force officers (TFOs) serving on FBI-led task forces; and

WHEREAS, the Amendment modifies the standing AFF Memorandum of Understanding between the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Atlantic City Police Department

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the City of Atlantic City to enter into agreement for said monies; and

WHEREAS, the FBI will reimburse the Atlantic City Police Department for the purchase – which must be invoiced to the FBI before September 15, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the property/equipment must not exceed a total cost of \$270,000.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Atlantic City that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and the City Clerk to attest to an Amended Agreement, and any other paperwork necessary to effectuate the receipt of the funding, between the City of Atlantic City and the Federal Bureau of Investigation Newark SSTF.
