Atlantic City Rail Line (ACRL)

Beginning Wednesday, September 5th and continuing until early 2019, NJ TRANSIT will continue the installation of Positive Train Control (PTC) equipment on our rail fleet throughout the state.

To accommodate this critical safety upgrade, all passenger service on the Atlantic City Rail Line (ACRL) will be temporarily suspended beginning Wednesday, September 5. Throughout this period, ACRL customers will have alternate travel options with discounted fares.

CAUTION although passenger train service will be suspended the tracks will still be active with freight train service and equipment movement. Officers or emergency response personnel should use extreme caution when entering any right-of-way and/or rail yard.

Officers or emergency response personnel <u>must make</u> <u>notification to the NJ Transit Police prior to entering upon any rail or light rail right-of-way and/or rail yard.</u> Please contact the New Jersey Transit Police Department Central Communications Center (1-800-242-0236 or 973-378-6565) to stop rail traffic and ensure officer safety.
